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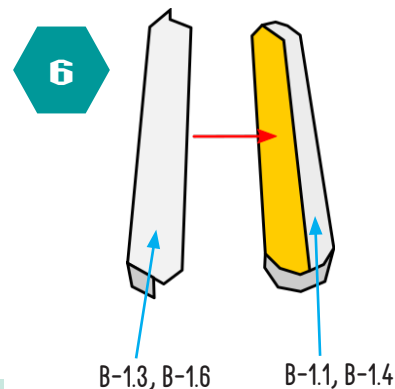
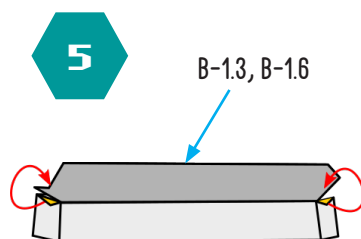
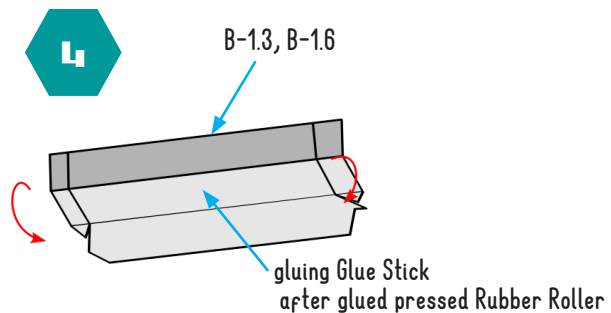
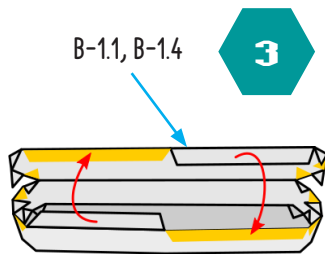
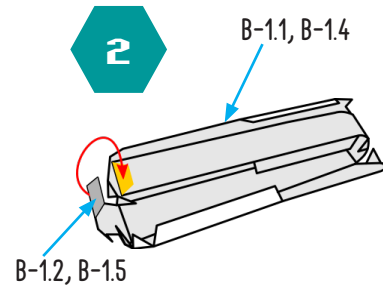
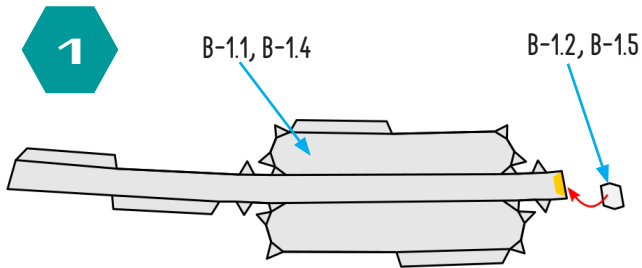
Suggested way perform

Model sheets print on **format A4 - 200 g / m²** paper or similar. The best effect will be on the **Matte Photo paper**. Model glueing glue with **PVA, White Glue** or **Vicol** or similar (for wood). In other elements use **Glue Stick**, this is stated in the instructions. Large glued flat parts must be pressed, for example with a rubber roller.

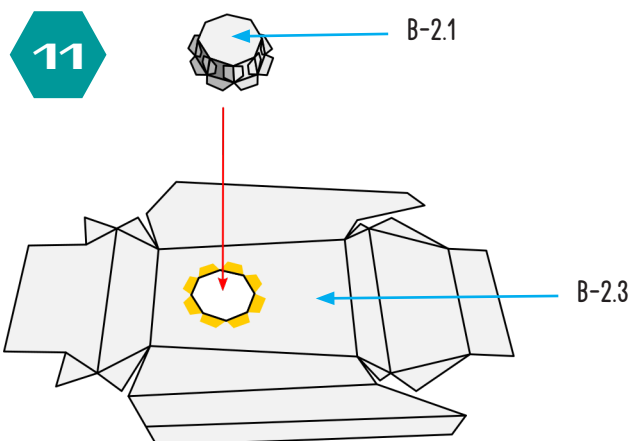
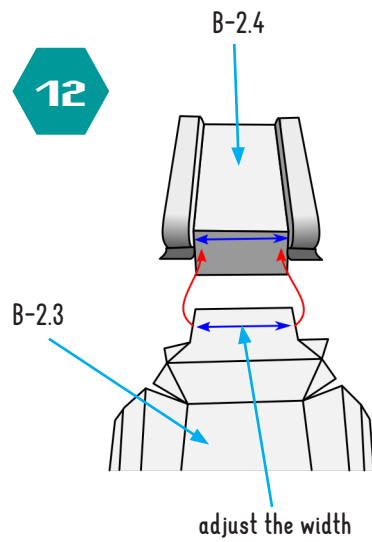
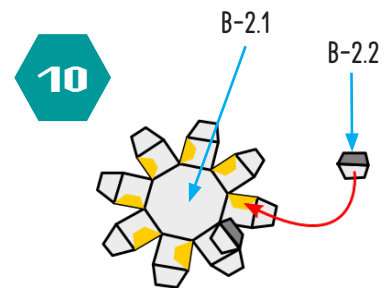
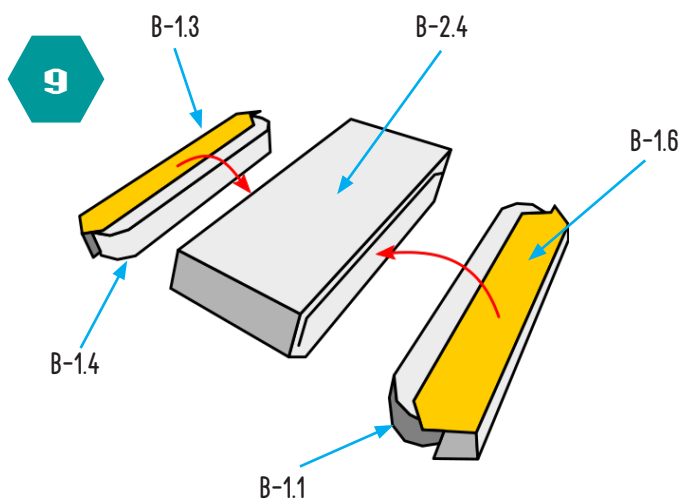
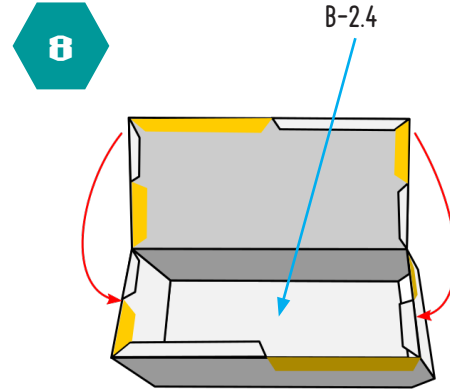
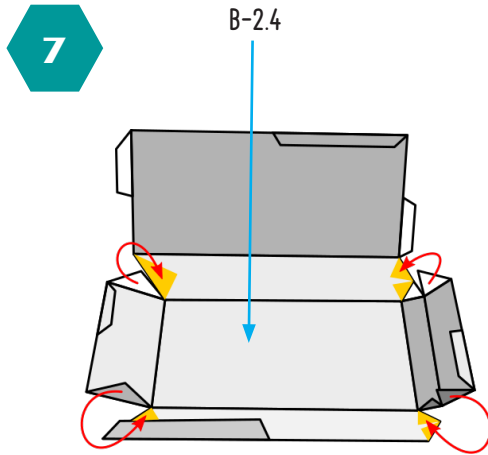
